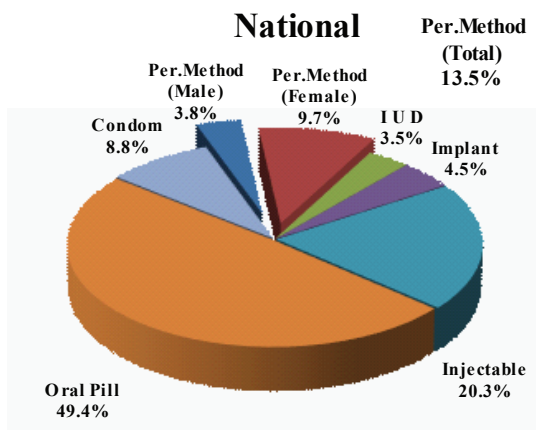



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

SUMMARY

Introduction

Bangladesh is divided into seven administrative divisions: Dhaka, Chittagong, Rajshahi, Khulna, Barisal, Sylhet and Rangpur. Each division is divided into several districts and each district into several upazilas. Each urban area in an upazila is divided into wards. Upazilas are divided into union parishads (UPs) and pourasovas. These divisions allow the country as a whole to be separated into rural and urban areas.

Management Information System (MIS) has been operational under the Directorate General of Family Planning (DGFP) for a long time. Contraceptive Performance, MCH, Reproductive Health and Nutrition service's report are used to be published each month from MIS Unit on the basis of Service Statistics received from the field workers, service delivery clinics and NGOs. Erstwhile Family Welfare Register, however, is the principal source of performance statistics. This report is prepared on the basis of FWA Registers (8th Edition). The FWA register (8th Edition) lunched; due to this reason couple registration has been started in January 2016 newly. At present, most of the FWAs visit their working area at a two-round. As a result, the family planning performance report of January 2016 is shown to a little bit change. It is a continuous process. FWA register modified every three years as program significantly.

There is a reporting system to collect the information from the field. MIS Reporting Form-1 is filled up by the FWAs and submitted the same to FPIs. FPI fills up the MIS reporting Form-2 by compiling of all the FWAs (MIS Form-1) report and submits to UFPO office. MIS reporting Form-3 (clinical) is filled up by MO(clinic)/(MCH-FP)/(FW)/SACMO/ FWV and is submitted to UFPO office. NGOs of the respective area submit their report to UFPO office through MIS reporting Form-2 and 3 as their requirement. All the reporting Form-2 and 3 are compiled by UFPO office and filled up reporting Form-4 (union wise) and is entered in online web based software (SS). District FP Office review and Submit that report. It provides information of contraceptive use status of eligible couples and different types of MCH, Reproductive Health and Nutrition services. MIS performance report is primarily used by different level of program managers and supervisors engaged in implementing the Family Planning, MCH, RH and Nutrition program in the country. Besides, different policy makers, decision makers, donor agencies, Development Partners, researchers and other users also use this report.

Family Planning Performance (CAR related):

Performance reports of February'16 have been received from all the 64 districts of the country. During the month of Feb'16 total numbers of eligible couple were found to be 26570556 as against 26742667 in the previous month. Performances of NGOs are also included in the report as reported by the Upazila Offices. A total of 20570950 acceptors are reported in the month of Feb'16 as against 20954430 in Jan'16. The Contraceptive Acceptance Rate (CAR) achieved at the end of the reporting month for six modern methods (Permanent Method, IUD, Implant, Injectables, Oral Pill and Condom) is 77.4 which was 78.4 in Jan'16. Method Specific Acceptors (Cumulative), Method Specific New Acceptors and Contraceptive distribution by Methods are shown in the summary sheet. It may be noted that the contraceptive acceptance rate is an estimate, based on the client contact and the status of contraceptive acceptance as reported by the field workers based on the entries made in the FWA register. The Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (CPR), on the other hand, is based on periodic surveys that are made on precise statistical procedures.

The acceptance rate is a tentative rate and varies from month to month because of reporting status and coverage. This rate is usually higher than the Contraceptive Prevalence Rate (CPR). CAR is generally used to monitor as a management tool 'on-going' program performance in the country. It is not so much used to evaluate the program impact or goals, which is done by periodical scientific surveys.

MCH Performance:

In the month of February'16, 1032086 pregnant women have been registered. Total number of 4004 pregnant women referred to hospital for their complications. Total no. of 79662 patient received services for RTI/STI. Dose-wise TT for Women (15-49 yrs.) and OPV & Pentavelant vaccines were shown in the summary sheet. BCG vaccines were given to 115531 infants and 111582 infants received Measles vaccines during February'16. Visit-wise Antenatal Care is also shown in the summary sheet both of January'16 and February'16. Postnatal Care is shown in the summary sheet both of January'16 and February'16. Number of delivery conducted by the clinics is 43974. Total numbers of Live Birth delivered at home 42763 by trained personnel and 14223 by non-trained personnel. Still Birth is recorded 226 in February'16 and in the previous month it was 204. Neo-natal deaths (0-28 days) & Infant deaths (29 days-<1yr.) are recorded to be 419 and 246 in the month of February'16 where it were 474 and 258 in January'16 respectively. A total of 294 child-deaths (1-<5 yrs.) have been reported in the month of February'16 as against 245 in January'16. Maternal deaths were reported 164 during the month of February'16 which was 146 in January'16. The Other deaths were reported 25778 in February'16 but in January'16 the number of such deaths were 27571. General treatments were rendered to 1524664 and 1901987 patients in the month of February'16 and January'16 respectively. In February'16 Number of ECP acceptors was 4318 but in January'16 it was 7743. MR done in the reporting month is 13392 but in January'16 it was 15514. Performance of MCHTI, MFSTC, MCWCs and FWVTI-Rajshahi is also included in the report.

Nutrition Programs of the Directorate General of Family Planning

Since 2011, the MCH Services Unit of the DGFP has been implementing MYCNSIA (Maternal and Young Child Nutrition Security Initiatives in Asia) in collaboration with UNICEF in 22 upazilas of 10 districts. The initiatives taken include: counseling to mothers/caregivers about IYCF, distribution of Micro Nutrient Powder (MNP) among 6-23 months old children, counseling of pregnant and lactating mothers on feeding practice and Iron Folic Acid (IFA), food security intervention, and hand-washing/hygiene practice in the communities. For implementing the MYCNSIA, MCH Services Unit of DGFP trained officials at various levels (both TOT and core training), developed training materials, developed web-based MIS, conducted baseline survey, and procured and distributed MNP sachets, etc. MCH Services Unit of DGFP will scale up nutrition intervention in other upazilas and districts gradually. Service registers and reporting formats were revised to include nutrition information. The DGFP's MIS is currently revisited for nutrition indicators and collected information.

Highlights February 2016

- a) National Contraceptive Acceptance Rate (CAR) based on 26570556 eligible couple visited, is found to be 77.4%. Rajshahi division has achieved the highest acceptance rate 79.9%, followed by Khulna division 79.3%. The CAR is found to be 78.6% achieved in Rangpur division. The Contraceptive

Acceptance Rate have been found to be rather low in Barisal 77.3%, Sylhet 77.0%, Dhaka 76.3%, and Chittagong 75.1% compared to other three divisions.

- b) The highest numbers of Acceptors 5748900 have been reported from Dhaka division followed by 3636060 in Chittagong division, Rajshahi division reported 3271407 acceptors respectively. Acceptors size is however, found much smaller in Rangpur, Khulna, Barisal, which are 2744156, 2710367, 1230908 and in Sylhet division it is 1229152.
- c) Out of 64 reporting districts, all districts have reported contraceptive acceptance rate of 70 percent and above, no district has reported CAR of 60 - 69 percent and no district have reported CAR of < 59.
- d) Out of 488 Upazila 480 have reported CAR at the level 70% and above, 7 Upazila has reported CAR level 60-69 percent and 1 Upazila has reported CAR level 0-59 percent.
- e) In case of performance done in the reporting month (February'16), Dhaka district recorded the highest Achievement Rate 77.2, Rajshahi has got the 2nd place with 72.7 and Khulna district has occupied the 3rd position with 70.8 of permanent method. Chittagong district has shown Achievement Rate 109.9 in IUD which is the first position among the other districts and Rangamati has got the 2nd place with 96.4. Sherpur district has recorded the highest Achievement Rate 202.2 in Implant. Bhola district has recorded the highest Achievement Rate of 167.7, Cox's Bazar placed in 2nd position with 116.6 and Laxmipur district has occupied the 3rd position with Achievement Rate 101.8 in Injectable. Mymensingh district has recorded the highest Achievement Rate 87.5 in Oral Pill and Sylhet district has recorded the highest Achievement Rate 105.6 in Condom.
- f) SMC has reported distribution of 135792 vial Injectable 3407821 cycles of oral pill and 8618790 pieces of condom in February 2016.
- g) Narsingdi MCWC have performed highest 41 Caesarian Operations, Gaibandha MCWC has performed highest of 265 deliveries. MCHTI, Dhaka has performed 230 C-Section and normal 94 (Total 324) deliveries MFSTC, Dhaka has performed 238 C-Section and normal 62 (Total 300) deliveries in the reporting month February'16. Joypurhat, Nilphamari, Lalmonirhat, Munshiganj, Sherpur, Jamalpur, Netrokona, Jessore, Magura, Meherpur, Kumarkhali(Kustia), Gournaadi(Barisal), Lalmohon(Bhola), Barguna, Pirojpur, Cox's Bazar, Bandarban, Begumganj(Noakhali), Pauchuria(Patiya), Bakolia Ctg. and Sylhet MCWCs have not done any Caesarian Operations. It may be due to the vacancies of trained EOC doctor in those centers or Extension Works. Director (MCH-S) & Line Director (MC&RH) should immediately look into the matter.
- h) In January 2016, Nutrition services information collect firstly at MIS formats. In February'16 National Nutrition services information which collected by FP workers are as follows: Number of 210896 mother received IFA, No. of 13683 child (6-23 months) received MNP sachet, No. of 40679 new born babies breast feeding within 1 hour after birth and 0-<6 months ages child 61213 exclusive breast feeding. No. of 5844 child suffering from MAM and 1623 suffering from SAM. No. of Child Stunting, wasting and underweight are 2659, 3803 and 4307 respectively.

Table Analysis:

Table 1: Shows contraceptive performance in respect of Permanent, Long Acting and Short Acting methods for the reporting month (February 2016) against their respective projections. In the reporting month the achievement rates of Permanent method (Male) are 26.5%, Permanent method (Female) 37.6% and average Permanent methods (Total) 32.1%, IUD 58.9%, Implant 82.0%, Injectables 70.4%, Oral Pill 58.1% and Condom 56.8%. From Jul'15 to Feb'16 the achievement rate of Permanent method (Male) is 34.7%, Permanent method (Female) 45.8% and Permanent methods (Total) 40.3%, IUD 66.9%, Implant 86.8%, Injectables 72.5%, Oral Pill 59.8% and Condom 58.3%.

- Table 2:** Shows the divisions according to descending order of achievement rate against their projection of Permanent and Long Acting methods for the period Jul'15 to February 2016.
- Table 3:** Showing the 3(three) districts achieved the highest achievement rate against Permanent and Long Acting methods of their projections for the period Jul'15 to February 2016.
- Table 4:** Shows the districts achieved the lowest achievement rate of Permanent and Long Acting methods against their projections for the period Jul'15 to February 2016.
- Table 5:** Comparative statement of contraceptive performance against their projection between the period of Jul'14 to Feb'15 and Jul'15 to Feb'16. The Achievement Rate of Permanent Method (Male) was 40.6% in the period of Jul'14 to Feb'15 but it shows the lower rate 34.7% in the current period. So it is 5.9% decrease than that of Jul'14 to Feb'15, Permanent Method (Female) was 49.2% in the period Jul'14 to Feb'15 but it shows the lower rate 45.8% in the current period. So it is 3.4% decrease than that of Jul'14 to Feb'15. Permanent Method (Total) was 45.0% in the period Jul'14 to Feb'15 but it shows the lower rate 40.3% in the current period. So it is 4.7% decrease than that of Jul'14 to Feb'15. IUD achieved the 66.9% in the reporting period but in Jul'14 to Feb'15 it achieved 67.7%. So in case of IUD 0.8% decrease in the reporting period. Implant achieved the 86.8% in the reporting period but in Jul'14 to Feb'15 it shows 93.4%, in that case Implant has shown 6.6% decrease in the reporting period. Injectable achieved the 72.5% in the current period but in the period Jul'14 to Feb'15 it shown 75.9%. Injectable has shown 3.5% decrease than that of Jul'14 to Feb'15. Oral Pill achieved the 59.8% in the present period but in the period Jul'14 Feb'15 it was 63.0%. Oral Pill decrease 2.9% than that of Jul'14 to Feb'15. In case of Condom it achieved 58.3% in the current period but in Jul'14 to Feb'15 it shown 61.1%, which is 2.7% decrease than that of Jul'14 to Feb'15.
- Table 6:** Compare the status of performance and distribution of contraceptive by methods for the month of January'16 and February'16 based on field worker's report. In comparison with that of previous month Permanent Method(male) 9.2%, Overall Permanent Method(total) 3.0%, IUD 14.2, Implant 1.3%, Oral Pill 1.3% and Condom 3.9% lower than that of January'16. On the other hand the performance of Permanent Method(female) 1.8% and Injectables 1.2% increased than that of January'16.
- Table 7:** Shows the share of Government and NGOs and Multisectors by methods in the overall National performance. Government sector has contributed 59.5 percent in Permanent Method (Male), 91.6 percent in Permanent Method (Female), 78.5 percent in Permanent Method (Total), 80.8 percent in IUD, 85.4 percent in Implant, 79.7 percent in Injectable, 84.8 percent in Oral Pill and 70.3 percent in Condom. On the other hand NGOs and Multisectors have contributed 40.5 percent in Permanent Method (Male), 8.4 percent in Permanent Method (Female), 21.5 percent in Permanent Method (Total), in IUD 19.2 percent, in Implant 14.6 percent, in Injectables 20.3 percent, in Oral Pill 15.2 percent and in Condom 29.7 percent in the reporting month February 2016.
- Table 8:** Division wise Contraceptive Performance by methods of NGOs and Multisectors (February 2016) are shown in this table Marie Stopes Clinic of Rajshahi division is in the highest position, BAVS of Dhaka division is in the next and Marie Stopes Clinic of Dhaka division is in the 3rd position in Permanent method. By NGOs and Multisectors performance of Total Permanent methods are 2507 in the reporting month, in which Males are 1926 and Females are 581. Total IUD and Implant 3207 and 4212 are inserted in the reporting month February 2016. Injectables 217986 vials, Oral Pill 1247447 cycles and 3407863 pieces of Condom are distributed by NGOs and Multisectors in this month.
- Table 9:** Shows the projection, performance and achievement rates of Permanent, and Long Acting methods in the reporting month February 2016. In reporting month Dhaka district has achieved the highest achievement rate of 77.2 percent and Rajshahi district is the next highest

with 72.7 percent in Permanent Method. Chittagong district has achieved the highest achievement rate of 109.9 percent in IUD and Sherpur district achieved the highest achievement rate of 202.2 percent in Implant. And in the reporting period Jul'15 to Feb'16, Dhaka district has achieved the highest achievement rate of 97.8 percent and Khulna is the next highest with 82.8 percent in Permanent Method. Bandarban has achieved the highest achievement rate of 123.3 percent in IUD and Thakurgaon has achieved the highest achievement rate of 165.6 percent in Implant.

Table 10: Shows the projection, performance and achievement rates of Short Acting methods in the reporting month February 2016. In reporting month Bhola district has achieved the highest achievement rate of 167.7 percent and Cox's Bazar is the next highest with 116.6 percent in Injectables. Mymensingh district have achieved the highest achievement rate of 87.5 percent in Oral Pill. Sylhet district has achieved the highest achievement rate of 105.6 percent in Condom. From Jul'15 to February 2016 Bhola district has achieved the highest achievement rate of 175.2 percent and Cox's Bazar is the next highest with 115.8 percent in Injectable. Mymensingh has achieved the highest achievement rate of 88.3 percent in Oral Pill and Dhaka has achieved the highest achievement rate of 115.9 percent in Condom.

In the summary sheet, Method Specific Acceptors is shown based on the field workers (FWA) visit of the reporting month and also the previous month. These are the cumulative figure which includes previous month's acceptors and reporting month's new acceptors collected by the field workers within their working areas.

Contraceptive distribution by Method:

In the summary sheet, Contraceptive Performance by Method is prepared based on the performance and distribution of the reporting month. These figures are actual performance of the reporting month which is not comparable with the information written in method specific acceptors.

Table- 9, Table-10 and Table-11

Performance shows in the table-9 and 10 is the actual performance of the respective month but the new acceptors show in the table-11 is may not be the performance done in the same month. It may happen that the new acceptors accepted method in the previous month but field workers shown that case in the next month due to their rounding schedule. So the performance of table-9, table-10 will not be the comparable with the new acceptor of table-11.

Clarification about the information of MCH and Reproductive Health Services:

- Information shown against 'delivery' which done in MCHTI, MFSTC, MCWCs, UHCs & UH&FWCs. This report is collected through the MIS reporting Form-3. So it is not the whole country's delivery records. This report is absolutely excluding the city corporations.
- Information shown against the 'live births (home)' based on field workers (FWA) report. Live births (clinic) are conducted at different types of clinic (MCH, DH, MCWCs, UHC, UH&FWC, NGO & Private clinics). Field workers visit their units monthly and they submit their report in every month.
